## 1. Purpose of the procedure

This document explains the rules that restrict the use of the different logos of mutual recognition agreements: “CCRA” and “SOGIS”. The logos concerned are the following:

## 2. Use of CCRA logo

The rules that supervise the use of the CCRA logo are described in the mutual recognition agreement: “Arrangement on the Recognition of Common Criteria Certificates in the fields of Information Technology Security” dated the 2<sup>nd</sup> of July 2014, Annex E, and can be downloaded on the ANSSI website ([www.ssi.gouv.fr](http://www.ssi.gouv.fr)) or on the website [www.commoncriteriaportal.org](http://www.commoncriteriaportal.org).

## 3. Use of SOGIS logo

The rules that supervise the use of SOGIS logo are described in the mutual recognition agreement: “Mutual Recognition Agreement of Information Technology Security Evaluation” of January 2010, Annex E, and can be downloaded on the ANSSI website ([www.ssi.gouv.fr](http://www.ssi.gouv.fr)) and on the SOG-IS website ([www.sogis.eu](http://www.sogis.eu)).

## 4. Response in the case of logo misuse

Any use of the CCRA or SOGIS mark which does not comply with these usage rules engages the usage right holder's responsibility and may lead to:

- the request for corrective actions within a fixed period of time;
- the immediate suspension of the usage right;
- the immediate withdrawal of the usage right, without prejudice to any legal proceedings and requests for reparation of the prejudice incurred by the ANSSI or the French Government due to this failure.

## 5. Penal sanctions

To misuse the CCRA or the SOGIS logos, to sell or to put on the market a product that have a misused logo is punishable by penal sanctions provided for by the L716-11 article of the intellectual property code.
